As the final act in my term as Chair of St. Paul's Hospital Foundation, I am proud to present our fifth annual *Report to the Community*.

In reflecting on our accomplishments in the 2011/2012 fiscal

year, I am truly amazed by what our donors have helped us achieve. This year, we saw St. Paul's Hospital Foundation reach a new level as a philanthropic organization. The Foundation raised \$15.99 million for equipment, research and patient care at St. Paul's – shattering our previous record of \$10.7 million.

We have many people to thank for this phenomenal achievement, including St. Paul's physicians, researchers and staff for inspiring us all with their commitment to serving the people of B.C.; our Board members for their leadership and guidance; and Foundation staff for their hard work.

Most of all, I thank the donors who generously support our world-leading patient care, research and teaching. We saw an example of the difference donors make during the Stanley Cup riot in Vancouver in June 2011. Just months after the completion of a three-year renovation project, made possible by donor

and government support, our Teck Emergency Centre faced one of the busiest nights ever experienced by a B.C. emergency department – and helped the city get through one of its darkest moments.

We saw many other amazing accomplishments from our donors throughout the year, including creating B.C.'s first research program to focus on the impact of gender-based differences on cardiovascular disease, completing a \$1-million campaign for a new vascular angiography system and supporting another successful Lights of Hope campaign.

Your generosity has made a difference in the lives of hundreds of thousands of patients throughout B.C. this year. My fellow Board members and I look forward to continuing to work with you in the coming years to achieve even greater successes and to prepare for the renewal of St. Paul's Hospital to enable us to better support patients across the province. 2011/2012 Donor Highlights

St. Paul's Hospital Foundation raised \$15.99 million in the 2011/12 fiscal year, the most in the Foundation's 32-year history.

Donors contributed to the care of 380,000 patients from across the province, and funded research and teaching that benefitted many more. Donors supported more than 20 areas and departments, including heart and lung, HIV/AIDS, mental health and addictions, renal (kidney), specialized needs in aging and urban health.

Here are just a few ways that St. Paul's donors helped support patients in B.C. and around the world.

Boehringer Ingelheim Physician Scholar Awards

Boehringer Ingelheim (Canada) Ltd., a world-leading pharmaceutical company, donated \$225,000 to both St. Paul's Hospital and Vancouver General Hospital to encourage the scientific development of the next generation of cardiologists and cardiac surgeons. The Boehringer Ingelheim Physician Scholar Awards provide significant funding for clinical research towards advancing cardiac care, which will directly benefit the thousands of patients treated at each hospital every year. The awards are designed to maximize and kick-start innovative research projects, and help to attract and retain the world's top medical talent.

UBC Heart and Stroke Foundation Professorship in Women's Cardiovascular Health

UBC Heart and Stroke Foundation Professorship in Women's Cardiovascular Health

Dr. Karin Humphries became the inaugural recipient of the UBC Heart and Stroke Foundation Professorship in Women's Cardiovascular Health at St. Paul's, the first program in B.C. to focus on the impact of gender-based differences on heart disease and stroke. A partnership between the University of British Columbia and St. Paul's Hospital, the Professorship was supported by \$1.25 million in one-time funding provided by the Ministry of Health through Cardiac Services BC, an agency of the Provincial Health Services Authority, \$500,000 from the Heart and Stroke Foundation of Canada and the contributions of other donors. Humphries will research the detection and early treatment of cardiovascular disease, strategies to improve outcomes for women at high risk, and new ways to improve the education of physicians, women and their families.

More than 400 donors completed a \$1-million campaign for a new vascular angiography system. This essential technology supports patients in all acute-care programs by generating images of the inside of blood vessels to diagnose problems, such as blood clots, and then facilitates interventional procedures to correct them. Replacing the old system was identified as the most critical major capital need in the Vancouver Coastal Health region.

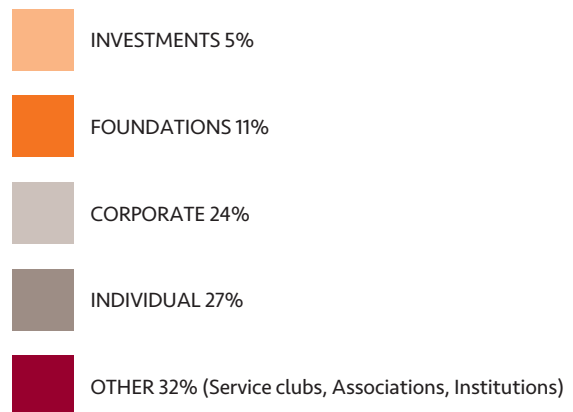
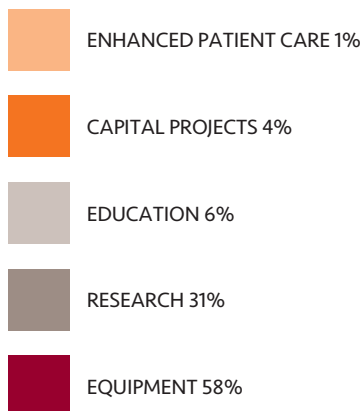
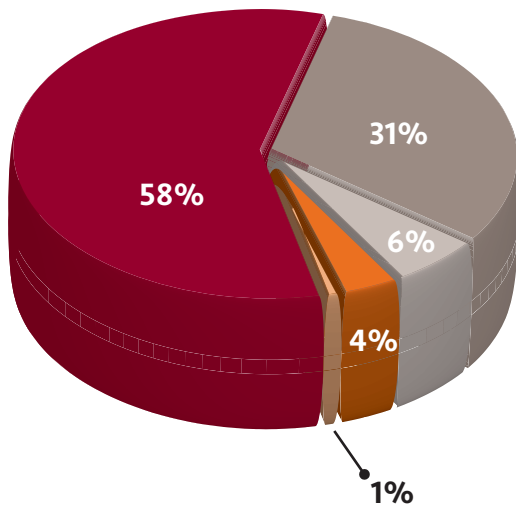
BREAKDOWN OF REVENUE

St. Paul's Hospital year in review



A Q & A WITH DIANNE DOYLE

President & CEO,
Providence Health Care

Dianne Doyle, president and CEO of Providence Health Care, which operates St. Paul's Hospital, reflects on the hospital's accomplishments and challenges over the past year and what lies ahead.

What were St. Paul's Hospital's major accomplishments this past year?

On a daily basis, I am fortunate to witness the positive outcomes St. Paul's Hospital's exemplary care, research and teaching initiatives have on our patients, residents, families and communities. The sheer number of achievements makes it hard to summarize them, but I'd like to note a few in particular.

St. Paul's amazing response to the Stanley Cup riot reinforced the need for our hospital to remain in the heart of Vancouver. That night – and throughout the year – our Emergency Department provided a shining example of the compassion, innovation and professionalism all our caregivers and medical staff demonstrate daily.

Our HIV/AIDS clinical program and BC Centre for Excellence (BC-CfE) in HIV/AIDS remained at the forefront of the nation and the world. At the request of the Saskatchewan Ministry of Health, we formed the Pacific to Prairies Partnership, in which our nurses are sharing best practices in working with HIV patients in marginalized populations with their provincial counterparts. In another major accomplishment, the BC-CfE's "treatment as prevention" strategy was named 2011's scientific breakthrough of the year by the prestigious *Science* magazine.

Our excellence and leadership in cardio-pulmonary care led to Vancouver Coastal Health designating St. Paul's as lead of the region's cardiac program – an important milestone for the hospital and Providence Health Care.

Our state-of-the-art biomarkers research at the Centre of Excellence for Prevention of Organ Failure (PROOF) is set to revolutionize the early detection of heart, lung or kidney disease through simple blood tests. The hospital also made exciting investments in women's heart health, cardiac rehab services, tele-health and urban health.

What are the major challenges facing St. Paul's?

Our main challenge continues to be having the appropriate physical space and infrastructure to best support our excellence in care, research and teaching. Issues with our building systems can create clinical and human resources challenges, including the recruitment and retention of new care-providers and researchers. Thankfully, last year, the provincial government provided \$17.2 million to address immediate electrical and elevator upgrades that are now underway.

Other challenges include: addressing increasing pressures on services within a tight fiscal environment; striving to continue to innovate while facing increased workload; upgrading patient information systems and our IT infrastructure, which we're beginning to deal with in a comprehensive way with our health authority partners; and raising funds to support the hospital's key needs for equipment, research and patient care.

What will be the impact of the future renewal of St. Paul's?

Feedback from patients and the public and the many local and international accolades our staff receive, demonstrate how much St. Paul's is loved and utilized by people throughout B.C. and relied upon as an engine for innovation. We are truly excited about the provincial government's commitment to the renewal of St. Paul's and look forward to working with St. Paul's Hospital Foundation to engage our donors, stakeholders and health partners to help develop a new ambulatory care centre and as well as other necessary hospital upgrades. ■
